

RULES & REGULATIONS



GENERAL

1. By registering for Padma Run Bandung 2026 (“Race”), Participants acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to fully comply with these Rules & Regulations.
2. The Race consists of two categories: 10K and 5K. Participants must meet the minimum age requirement of 17 years old on 4 October 2026 (Race Day), or otherwise provide valid [parental/guardian consent](#), failing which the Competition Organizers reserve the right to deny participation.
3. The podium prizes for Padma Run Bandung 2026 will be awarded to the winners in the Men's and Women's categories, in both Open and Master divisions.
4. Participants are strongly advised to seek medical advice from a doctor regarding their health condition before participating in the Race. Participants declare that they are in good health and medically fit to participate and understand that participation in the Race is voluntary and involves inherent risks, including but not limited to physical injury, illness, disability, death, accidents, weather conditions, and other foreseeable or unforeseeable risks (“Risks and Hazards”).
5. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Participants hereby assume all such Risks and Hazards and waive, release, and discharge Padma Hotel Bandung and the Race organizers (“Competition Organizers”) from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, or losses arising out of or in connection with participation in the Race, including but not limited to Risks and Hazards, late arrival, pre-existing medical conditions, accidents during the Race, and/or loss or damage to personal property.
6. Participants further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Competition Organizers from any claims arising from their participation or breach of these Rules & Regulations. Participants authorize the Competition Organizers to arrange emergency medical treatment if necessary, with all associated costs borne by the Participant.

7. Participants must complete the Race within the official Cut-Off Time (COT) to be eligible for finisher entitlements, and official timing results shall be determined solely by the Competition Organizers. Participants who do not meet the Cut-Off Time and participants who are disqualified shall be considered as participants who did not complete the Race and therefore will not be entitled to receive finisher medals.
8. The BIB number is personal, non-transferable, and must be worn visibly at all times during the Race. The sale, misuse, and/or transfer of Race entries or BIB numbers are strictly prohibited and may result in disqualification and/or prohibition from future events. The Competition Organizers reserve the right to withhold the BIB number and race pack under certain conditions, including violations of these Rules & Regulations, indications of forgery, and/or similar conditions.
9. Registration fees are non-refundable, except where otherwise determined at the sole discretion of the Competition Organizers, including in cases of event cancellation, postponement, or modification due to Force Majeure or other circumstances beyond reasonable control. The Competition Organizers reserve the right to modify the Race route, schedule, format, or categories as necessary. The Competition Organizers also reserve the right to reject registrations that have been confirmed if false, fake, misleading, and/or incomplete information is found in the registration form.
10. All intellectual property rights in relation to the Race, including but not limited to photos, videos, timing data, articles, publications, broadcasts, and promotional materials, are owned by the Competition Organizers. Participants grant a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free consent for the use of their name, image, voice, race results, and personal information such as age and domicile for promotional, publication, documentation, and commercial purposes in any media format.
11. Participants also consent to the collection, storage, processing, and use of their personal data by the Competition Organizers in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

12. The Competition Organizers reserve the right to amend, revise, or update these Rules & Regulations at any time without prior notice, and Participants are responsible for regularly reviewing the latest version published through official Padma Hotel Bandung communication channels. Additional conditions not yet listed in these Rules & Regulations may be determined later by the Competition Organizers.
13. These Rules & Regulations shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Indonesia. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with the Race shall first be resolved amicably, failing which such disputes shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Bandung, Indonesia.

RACE DAY

1. Participants are required to enter the starting line and commence the Race strictly at the scheduled time of 5:00 AM (GMT +07:00). Failure to start within the designated time may result in disqualification from Padma Run Bandung 2026.
2. Participants must run in a safe and orderly manner, avoid disrupting other participants, give way to faster runners, and refrain from stopping abruptly along the race route unless necessary. Any unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to blocking, obstructing, or endangering other participants, may result in immediate disqualification at the sole discretion of the Competition Organizers.
3. Participants are required to follow all signage, kilometer markers, and official instructions along the race route at all times.
4. Official photographers and videographers will be present at the Start/Finish area as well as along the race course. By participating in the Race, Participants consent to being photographed, filmed, and/or recorded for promotional, publication, and commercial purposes by the Competition Organizers.
5. Participants are required to dispose of waste properly in designated bins provided at the Race Village and water station areas. Participants are also strongly encouraged to maintain adequate hydration throughout the Race.

6. Each Participant will be assigned a BIB number embedded with an official timing chip, which must be worn visibly at all times during the Race. Timing checkpoints will be implemented at designated locations to ensure compliance with the official race course. Participants who fail to follow the designated race route, miss timing checkpoints, or manipulate timing records will be disqualified from Padma Run Bandung 2026.
7. Participants who are unable or decide to stop the Race for any reason must immediately inform the nearest marshal and follow the marshal's instructions to safely exit the course, including transportation back to the Start/Finish area if necessary.
8. The Competition Organizers will provide ambulance and medical support, including one ambulance stationed at the Race Village at Padma Hotel Bandung and additional ambulance support deployed along the race route. Participants acknowledge and understand that medical response times may vary depending on race and traffic conditions.
9. Participants are advised that certain sections of the road may be uneven or contain hazards such as potholes, slippery surfaces, or other obstacles. Participants are required to exercise maximum caution and remain aware of their surroundings at all times during the Race.
10. The Competition Organizers reserve the right to impose additional safety measures, including but not limited to route adjustments, temporary race stoppages, participant removal, and/or event modifications where deemed necessary for safety, operational, weather, or emergency reasons.

POTENTIAL WINNERS

1. Any Participant identified as a potential winner ("Winner") must have properly worn the assigned BIB number and official timing chip throughout the Race and must present valid and official identification in order to claim any prize. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in disqualification and forfeiture of prize entitlement at the sole discretion of the Competition Organizers.

2. All Potential Winners are required to immediately proceed to the designated verification tent upon crossing the finish line and undergo the official verification process conducted by the Competition Organizers.
3. The verification process shall only be deemed valid upon issuance of the official verification lanyard by the Competition Organizers and must be completed within a maximum period of thirty (30) minutes from the time the Participant finishes the Race.
4. Any Potential Winner who fails to complete the verification process within the specified timeframe shall be deemed to have voluntarily withdrawn as a potential winner and shall no longer be eligible to claim any prize thereafter. No additional or subsequent verification requests shall be entertained under any circumstances.
5. The Competition Organizers reserve the absolute right to verify race results, participant identity, eligibility, and compliance with these Rules & Regulations, and to disqualify any Participant in the event of suspected fraud, misconduct, rule violations, timing irregularities, unauthorized assistance, or any other actions deemed inconsistent with the spirit of fair competition.
6. All prizes, including cash prizes, are subject to applicable tax laws and government regulations in the Republic of Indonesia. Any taxes, duties, withholding obligations, administrative fees, or other charges arising from the receipt of prizes shall be fully borne by the respective Winners.
